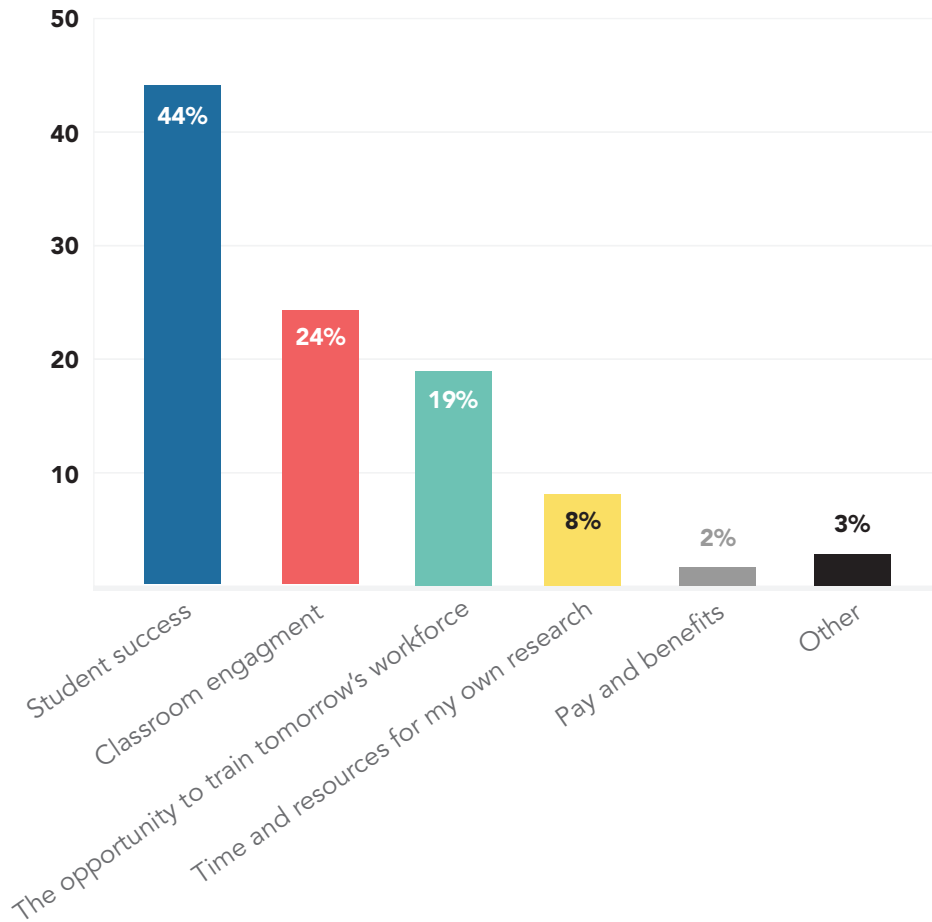


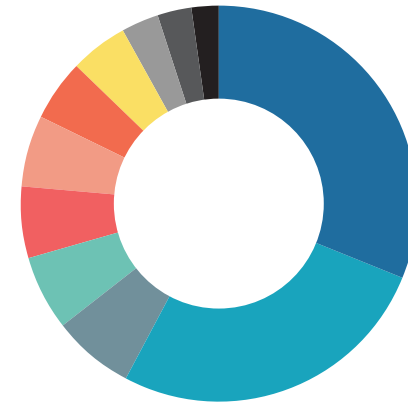
Teaching in Higher Education:

What Faculty Find Most Frustrating*



- 32% Unengaged or unprepared students
- 27% Too much work and too little time to do it
- 7% Insufficient pay or benefits
- 6% Lack of resources
- 6% Non-educators influencing how I teach
- 6% Poor communication from colleagues/admin
- 6% Poor tech infrastructure
- 5% Poor job security
- 3% Class sizes
- 3% Lack of recognition
- 2% Other

*Based on a survey of 289 higher-education faculty members conducted by Kivuto in 2017. Respondents were asked "What do you value most in your job?" and "What is the most frustrating or challenging part of your job?"
